

- (1) The Share Your Heart/DCF Volunteer Chaplaincy Program consists of an introduction and orientation of the program with clergy and eligible religious leaders held at one of the Department of Children and Families Investigation (DCF) Hubs.
- (2) The orientation is followed by the 16 Hour Training for 4 consecutive weeks. These trainings were designed specifically for the Department of Children and Families Investigation referrals that deals with Families in Crisis. The curriculum was developed and the course is taught by certified professional chaplains from Congregational Health of Baptist Health South Florida. We offer these trainings every other month (or as needed) for 50 to 100 pastors and church leaders.
- (3) After your graduation you would have had your background check ,ID Card , and T-shirt , now you are ready to be deployed to one of our DCF, Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Elder –Links Program, Juvenile Assessment Center or Community Victims Center referral.

Note: This Chaplaincy program is based on expanding the Kingdom of God's Love (72hr Food & Clothing) and spiritual support to the people of your zip code. You the Chaplain represent your faith-based organization to be trained, equipped, certified by the state, local authorities and Federal government with your trainings. We have the **memorandum of understanding** that allowed you to give spiritual support and welcome them into your faith community for support.



#### I. Purpose

The purpose of this Working Agreement is to coordinate support services provided by Victory for Youth's Share Your Heart Program which are available to families who are the subject of an investigation of abuse, neglect or abandonment by the Department of Children and Families ("Department") in Miami-Dade County.

#### II. Parties:

- The Child Protective Investigators ("CPI") of the Department are responsible for investigating allegations of abuse, neglect or abandonment of children by caregivers, and ensuring the safety of children and supporting families in providing a nurturing and safe environment for children to grow.
- Victory for Youth program is a 501(C) (3) non-for profit organization providing services to needy families in Miami-Dude County. The Share Your Heart Program is a component of Victory for Youth that works as a Chaplaincy Program which prepares Churches to provide services to clients through trained participants.

#### III. Tasks

#### The Department

- The Department's CPI's will identify a family's needs during the course of an abuse investigation.
- Based on their assessment of the family's needs, the CPI will make a service referral to
   Victory for Youth to provide the requested support services to help stabilize the family.
- · Referrals will only be made for families voluntarily requesting services.

#### Victory For Youth

 Victory for Youth will adopt the three (3) Service Centers which house CPT's in Miami-Dade County: the North, Central and South Service Centers. Victory for Youth will provide and maintain a child friendly play room in each Service Center with necessary

supplies, such as non-perishable food, games, diapers and formula that promote a positive and caring environment for the children's visit to the Service Center.

- Victory for Youth will provide referrals for receptive clients that are facing challenges in their families to faith-based organizations and other resources, such as health care organizations which will help in dealings with these challenges.
- Victory for Youth will provide career opportunities such as work placement and job trainings through the vocational rehabilitation program.
- Victory for Youth's Share Your Heart Program will forward each referral received to the
  participating faith-based organization in the client's zip code catchment area. The
  organization in each zip code will be assigned clients on a wheel rotation established by
  Victory for Youth.
- Victory for Youth will ensure that the faith-based organization will promptly contact the family to offer assistance with food, clothing, and spiritual care, if requested by the family.
- Victory for Youth will ensure the confidentiality of referred families is maintained at all times.
- Victory for Youth will immediately discontinue any services should a family decide to not to participate in any program.

#### IV. Points of Contact

The Share Your Heart Program will designate individuals, telephone numbers as points of contact to share information, maintain routine contact and resolve areas of conflict. Approved list will be made available to the Department by the Share Your Heart Program and updated on a continuing basis.

#### V. Termination Clause

This Agreement will be reviewed every two (2) years for renewal. Either party may terminate this Agreement upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party.

#### VI. Authority

Each person signing this Agreement on behalf of either party individually warrants that he or she has full legal power to execute this Agreement.



As with any **re-building** project, Nehemiah first had to remove the **rubble**.





#### Approximately 445-432 B.C.

Nehemiah was a common person in a unique position. He was secure and successful as cupbearer to the Persian king. Nehemiah had great influence. He was trusted by the king. He was also a man of God, concerned about the fate of Jerusalem.

While Nehemiah was serving the king wine the king noticed that Nehemiah 's heart was sad and asked Nehemiah why? Nehemiah answered the king "why should my face not look sad when the city where my fathers are buried lies in ruins and its gates have been destroyed and its **people are suffering**?" Nehemiah was very much concerned about the welfare of the Israelites.

The king then asked Nehemiah "What is it that you want?" Nehemiah **prayed** to the God of heaven and answered the king according to God's plan. Nehemiah asked the king to send him to the city to rebuild it. Furthermore, he asked the king for letters to the governors. With these royal letters from the king Nehemiah would receive the open doors and provisions needed and all the supplies needed for the task and journey ahead in order to return back faster. Because the gracious hand of God was upon Nehemiah, the king granted his requests. Nehemiah then organized people into groups and assigned them to specific sections of the wall. As we know the construction project was not without opposition, but with prayer, encouragement, guard duty and unity the construction was done. **After building the walls, Nehemiah continued to organize the people, by appointing gatekeepers.** This led to a reaffirmation of faith and revival as the people promised to serve God faithfully and the mission was completed.

## AFTER SCHOOL CARE PROGRAM GATE ADMINISTRATION

In order for Victory for Youth to provide free meals to our children in the After School Care Program, we must show proof that we are a self-sustaining organization by having \$50,000. By having this pre-requisite met they will provide meals at no cost and we will be able to feed 100 children every night. For many children this may be the only nutritional meal that they will eat in the afternoon/evening.

#### **PLAN OF ACTION:**

 $3.00 \times 100 \text{ children} = 300.00 \text{ Daily} \times 7 \text{ days} = 2,100.00 \times 12 \text{ weeks} = 25,200.00 \text{ per Gate}$ 

\$500.00 one time donation from 40 Faith Based Site = \$ 20,000 in each Region ( Gate )

\$20,000 x 3 Regions (South, North, Central Gates) \$60,000

This will give us the required amount to operate this program.

After this initial investment, this program will be self-sustaining at 0 cost to us.

Each participating Faith-Based Site will invest in the program with a one-time seed donation of \$500.00 They will also provide the manpower for a maximum of 2 weeks of the year, to help host the program at specific sites that the USDA indicates have the greatest need to reach out to the children within their respective communities.

Please note this "seed money" will be kept in a specified bank account to be used only for the afterschool program as voted by each Gate Advisory Board in order to secure financial sustainability.
